HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE B. CHANDRA KUMAR CRIMINAL PETITION No.7850 OF 2013

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is filed by the petitioner – accused No.3, A.N.V.S.D. Kumar for grant of anticipatory bail in Crime No.49 of 2011 on the file of Addateegala Police Station, East Godavari District, registered against him and others for the offences punishable under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

- 2. This Court, by order dated 19-02-2013 in Criminal Petition No.1021 of 2013, dismissed the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner. It appears that the Additional Joint Collector, East Godavari District at Kakinada, submitted a report to the District Collector showing the role played by the petitioner in misappropriation of government money. It is alleged in the report that the petitioner obtained Demand Drafts in favour of his name and his spouse name and misappropriated the government money and that he is the main person for the entire scam. The total amount said to have drawn under different heads and misappropriated is Rs.19,20,663/-.
- 3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the wife of the petitioner died on 08-06-2013; and that the petitioner is the only person to look after his children and thus, requested to grant anticipatory bail.
- 4. The reasons assigned by the learned counsel for the petitioner do not entitle the petitioner to grant bail. Hence, this

Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.

6. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this petition, shall stand dismissed.
