TRANSFER CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS PETITION No.673 of 2012

ORDER:

Respondent filed O.P.No.117 of 2012 on the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Siddipet, Medak District giving the following address:

H.No.9-27/2, Near Krishnapur Kaman, Brahmana Veedi, Toopran, Medak District.

- 2. Petitioner has taken out notice to the respondent to the same address mentioned above. In spite of taking notice to the same address two times, the notice has been returned with endorsement 'addressee is continuously absent for seven days'. Since notice has been taken to the same address given by the respondent, it is deemed that the notice has been served on the respondent. There is no need to issue any fresh notice. Respondent is called absent and set *ex parte*.
- 3. Petitioner is the wife of the respondent. Their marriage was solemnized on 08.05.1998 at Vasavi Kalyana Mandapam, Mangalagiri. Petitioner filed M.C.No.63 of 2012 on the file of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Mangalagiri seeking maintenance. The case of the petitioner is that she cannot travel along with her two minor children to Siddipet from Mangalagiri and she has no source of income to meet the travelling expenses.

- 4. Having regard to the difficulties expressed by the petitioner, O.P.No.117 of 2012 on the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Siddipet is withdrawn and transferred to the Court of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Mangalagiri to be tried along with M.C.No.63 of 2012.
- 5. Accordingly, Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed. Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed. There shall be no order as costs.
