MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order dated 31.10.2012 required the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization in the light of the judgment of this Court which was appended to the writ petition as Annexure P-5.

An order dated 12.7.2013 has been produced before this Court and the same is taken on record as mark 'A' which indicates that the services of the petitioner have since been regularized in terms of the policy decision of the State of Haryana. It has further been ordered that the pay of the incumbent be fixed in the regular capacity w.e.f. 1.10.2003.

This satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner but he states that the respondents be directed to release the consequential benefits arising from the order as expeditiously as possible.

Having regard to the aforesaid, rule against the respondents is discharged with a stipulation that they shall release the consequential

benefits to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
