The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 19.05.2012, registered under Sections 307, 379, 325, 341, 506, 148, 149, 397 of the Indian Penal Code (for Short, 'the IPC') (Sections 307/379 IPC deleted as per the challan), at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners could not appear on account of medical problem on 16.04.2013, and the bail bonds of the petitioners were cancelled and security forfeited on account of their absence. The learned counsel contends that petitioner No.2 was seriously ill. However, he appeared

before the Court in the evening but by that time, the order had already been passed.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

Without going into the merits, this petition is disposed of and it is ordered that in case the petitioners surrender before the concerned Court within three days from today, they shall be admitted to bail subject to their furnishing fresh bail bonds, to its satisfaction.
