The Investigating Officer is present in Court.

Sonu son of Ajaib Singh and Sonu son of Mangi have been arrested. The proceedings for declaring Kewal Singh as proclaimed offender are in progress, who is yet to be arrested. The prayer in the petition for direction to arrest the private respondents and to seek protection for life and liberty apparently would be, to an extent, satisfied. Since the State has taken action to get Kewal Singh declared proclaimed offender, let the process take its own course. If the petitioner's life or liberty is under any threat, she may approach the Senior Superintendent of Police of the District concerned, who will appreciate the threat perception and take action in accordance with law.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
