After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order dated 20.5.2013 (Annexure P-9) having been passed by the Financial Commissioner directing the Deputy Commissioner to complete the enquiry within a period of 30 days, he will not be in a position to substantiate his arguments, at this stage. Thus, he rightly seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the matter with the Deputy Commissioner and if necessity arises with the Financial Commissioner as well.
