They further submit that in view of the out of court settlement arrived at between the petitioners and the private respondents, let the order dated 18.7.2012 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur Canal Circle, Ferozepur-respondent No.1, be set aside remanding the matter back to respondent No.1 to decide the matter afresh, in terms of the compromise, arrived at between the parties.

aside. The matter is remanded back to respondent No.1 to decide afresh,

in terms of compromise arrived at between the parties. The parties are

directed to appear before the Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur

Canal Circle, Ferozepur-respondent No.1 on 29.5.2013. The

Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur Canal Circle, Ferozepur-

respondent No.1 is directed to decide the matter afresh, in terms of the

compromise arrived at between the parties, by passing an appropriate

order, in accordance with law, at an early day but in any case within a

period of three months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
