The petitioner, who is a lady constable under the Haryana Police has approached this Court impugning the order dated 3.12.2013, whereby she has been transferred from Faridabad to Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would vehemently contend that Fatehabad is at a distance of approximately 200 kms. away from Faridabad and in the light of the impugned order of transfer the petitioner would face a lot of practical difficulties as her matrimonial home is at Faridabad, wherein her husband is doing some private business. That apart, counsel would submit that the petitioner has a minor child, who has to be looked after.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, I am of the considered view that the instant writ petition deserves dismissal. Transfer is an incidence of service.

On a pointed query having been put to counsel, it has been conceded that the petitioner was initially appointed in the year 2007 and ever since that date has served in Faridabad itself. No infirmity can be found in the impugned order of transfer, whereby the petitioner is being dislocated from Faridabad to Fatehabad after having enjoyed a tenure at Faridabad itself for a period of almost 7 years.

No merit, petition dismissed.
