- The petitioner is Head Mistress in Government Primary School. She is aggrieved by the impugned transfer order which has been passed pursuant to the new Transfer Rules known as "Uttarakhand Teacher (School Education) First Appointment, Promotion and Posting on Transfer Rules, 2013" (hereinafter referred to as Transfer Rules).
- 2. The controversy involved in this matter has been adjudicated by this Court in Writ Petition No. 750 of 2013 (Mahipal Singh Rathor and others v. State of **Uttarakhand)** and in other connected matters decided on 30.7.2013, where this Court has declined to interfere in the transfer of the teachers done in pursuance of the new Transfer Rules, where both the validity of these Rules as well as the "grading system" given to teachers and the schools, which forms the basis of these transfers has been upheld.
- 3. Therefore, the present writ petition is also liable to be dismissed in the same terms and conditions as made

in Writ Petition No. 750 of 2013 (Mahipal Singh Rathor and others v. State of Uttarakhand) and is hereby dismissed, subject to the terms and conditions of the above writ petition.

4. No order as to costs.
