By this application, the applicant has prayed for quashing the entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 304 of 2011 (Old No.970 of 2009), Baldev Raj Bajaj Vs. Satish Chand Mehta, u/S 323 of I.P.C., Police Station Ranipur, District Haridwar.

During the course of the hearing of this petition, the parties have filed the Compounding Application supported by affidavits of both the parties. In the affidavit, it has been stated that the parties have amicably settled their dispute outside the court and they will not proceed with the proceedings of the case. They have further stated that the parties have entered into amicable settlement outside the court and there is no further dispute between the parties.

Considering that the parties have entered into an amicable settlement, no useful purpose will be served to prolong the pendency of the case. This is also the ratio of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **B.S. Joshi and others Vs. State of Haryana and another, 2003 SCC (Cri) p/848**.

Considering the above facts and the principle laid down by the Apex Court, I am of the view that the parties have entered into a compromise and have settled their dispute outside the Court, entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 304 of 2011 (Old No.970 of

2009), Baldev Raj Bajaj Vs. Satish Chand Mehta, u/S 323 of I.P.C., Police Station Ranipur, District Haridwar are hereby quashed in view of the compromise arrived in between the parties.

Compounding application is disposed of. The petition also stands disposed of accordingly.
