By way of present application / petition, moved under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the applicants seek to set aside the entire proceedings of criminal complaint case no. 198 of 2007, Harvinder Kaur vs. Mohan Singh and others under Sections 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, pending in the court of Special Judicial Magistrate I, Dehradun.

2) A compromise was entered into between Smt. Harvinder Kaur (respondent no. 2) and Mohan Singh (applicant no. 1), whereby it was decided between them that the pending matter shall be got disposed of by them in terms of compromise dated 19.03.2010. The terms of settlement, which was agreed to between Smt. Harvinder Kaur and Mohan Singh were mentioned in Annexure R.A. 1 to the petition. It was indicated in the said compromise dated 19.03.2010 that Smt. Harvinder Kaur has received a lump sum

amount of Rs. 1,50,000/- as permanent alimony. It was also agreed to between the parties that case crime no. 193 of 2006 will also be got settled by them in the light of this compromise, as also the proceedings under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. The husband and wife also obtained a decree of divorce from the Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun on 19.03.2010 in pursuance of the compromise dated 19.03.2010. This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is thus disposed of in terms of compromise entered into between Smt. Harvinder Kaur and Mohan Singh.

3) The proceedings of criminal complaint case no. 198 of 2007, Harvinder Kaur vs. Mohan Singh and others under Sections 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, pending in the court of Special Judicial Magistrate I, Dehradun are hereby quashed.
