This is a bail application seeking regular bail in Case Crime No. 261 of 2012 under Section 489-D IPC, Police Station Patel Nagar, District Dehradun.

Mr. Sandeep Tandon, learned counsel, appearing for the applicant, submits that applicant has moved First Bail Application No. 77 of 2013 before this Court in the month of January and by that time charge-sheet was not filed and case was registered against the applicant under Sections 420, 468, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C and 120-B and applicant was granted bail under those Sections. Thereafter 489-D was also added; he further submits that co-accused Ashish Das, moved bail application no. 387 of 2013 under Section 489-D too, since, by that time, charge-sheet was filed before the Court concerned. Mr. Sandeep Tandon, learned counsel for the applicant further contends that in view of the fact that co-accused Ashish Das, has already been granted bail under Section 489-D IPC, therefore, applicant is also entitled for bail on the principle of parity.

Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, bail application is allowed. I direct, let the accused / applicant be

released on bail on furnishing his personal bond of ₹50,000/- and two sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dehradun under Section 489-D too.
