## WPCRL No.1002 of 2013 Hon'ble V.K. Bist, J.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This matter was referred to the Mediator. Parties appeared before the Mediator and have amicably voluntarily settled their disputes and have decided to live together. However, both the parties have agreed to some conditions put up by either of the party. The said conditions are hereunder:

- 1. Petitioner no.3 (husband) Shri Karan Vir Singh Ghumman will take all steps to economically secure the future of respondent no.4 (wife) Smt. Manpreet Kaur.
- 2. Both the parties have amicably and voluntarily agreed that they will live together harmoniously at the home of the petitioner no.3 (husband) which is the matrimonial home of the respondent no.4 (wife). The said home is in the form of farmhouse situated at Village Bichpuri, Tehsil Bazpur, District Udham Singh Nagar.
- 3. Both the parties will withdraw all civil or criminal case pending before any competent Court either in Uttarakhand or at any other place.

- 4. Both the parties will respect each other and also their respective family members.
- 5. Both the parties have agreed that on the basis of this compromise, the Writ Petition No.1002 of 2013 pending at this Court may be disposed of and if permitted by law, the F.I.R. in question may be quashed.
- 6. Petitioner no.1 and 2 also agree to the aforesaid terms and conditions of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties made statement that the parties undertake to withdraw all the pending civil and criminal cases.

In view of undertaking given by the parties and after considering the report of the Mediator, the criminal writ petition is allowed. The F.I.R. No.204 of 2013 dated 15.08.2013, filed under Section 498-A, 307, 504, 506, 342 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, registered at P.S. Bazpur, district Udham Singh Nagar, is hereby quashed.

Parties are directed to file a copy of this order before the learned Magistrate before whom the charge sheet has been filed.

Compounding application is, accordingly, disposed of.
