BY THE COURT: -

This writ petition is directed against the order of the Board of Revenue dated 11/11/2005 whereby, it has reversed the order of the Revenue Appellate Authority dated 30/5/2001 maintaining order of temporary injunction passed by the Sub Divisional Officer, Ajmer dated 15/12/2000 in a suit filed at the instance of plaintiff-petitioner for declaration along with temporary injunction application, against the defendant-respondents.

This writ petition has remained pending before this Court for last seven years. This Court vide order dated 20/12/2005 directed the parties to maintain status-quo. As already seven years have passed, it is not deemed appropriate to vacate the same. The said interim-order will be co-terminus with disposal of the revenue suit filed by the petitioner. The Sub Divisional Officer, Ajmer is directed to decide the said suit within a period of one year from the date next fixed before it.

With that direction, writ petition stands disposed of.
