Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the graduation

certificate appended as Annexure No. 2 should be treated to be a

requisite qualification for the purpose of computing 10+2+3

qualification as required for B.T.C. Training.

The claim of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that the

certificate possessed by the petitioner is not equivalent or

acceptable and recognized by the Respondent.

Learned Standing counsel contends that similar writ petitions

bearing No.s 32668 of 2010 and 3385 of 2011 have already been

dismissed on 28.5.2010 and 24.1.2011 respectively.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, there is no material

to indicate that the graduation certificate possessed by the

petitioner has been recognized by the Respondent as an equivalent

certificate. Apart from this, it is no longer necessary to keep the

matter pending as the issue in the aforesaid writ petitions have

already been dealt with at length.

Writ petition lacks merit and is dismissed.
