This application has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner who has been made an accused in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 7, 13(2) read with 13(1)(D) of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

The petitioner is solitary named accused in this case on being apprehended during trap with Rs. 4000/- taken as bribe.

Submission is of false implication under confusion. However, taking into consideration after completing investigation charge-sheet has already been submitted and now there is nothing to be investigated and interrogated.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only)



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Vigilance (Trap Case), Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 07/2014 arising out of Vigilance (Patna) P.S. Case No. 03/2014, with a condition to remain physically present before the court below on each and every date till disposal of the case, in case of failure on two consecutive dates without giving any reasonable explanation, the liberty granted shall be deemed to be cancelled.
