Heard both sides.

The petitioner is an accused in Gadhpura P.S. case No.129 of 2013 registered for the offence under Sections 363 and 366A of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an old man, aged about 89 years and on mere suspicion name of the petitioner has been dragged in the case of kidnapping of minor girl. Informant has only suspected the name of the petitioner. Hence the petitioner, who is in jail since 9.12.2013, be enlarged on bail.

Learned Additional P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record.

From perusal of the F.I.R., it appears that the informant is not an eye witness of the occurrence and he suspected the hand

of the petitioner along with Shamsher Safi and Kasim Safi.

Petitioner is an old man and he has already remained in jail for more than five months.

Considering the facts and nature of allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner has remained in jail for more than five months, I find that the petitioner deserves bail. Accordingly the prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Gadhpura P.S. case No.129 of 2013.
