Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners are accused in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 227 of 2013 registered under Section 411, 413 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is that three persons were seen on motorcycle in suspicious condition and they entered into a hut, from where, five persons including these petitioners were apprehended and on search, two bags were seized, in which, 42 pieces of camera and 8 Samsung mobile were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case mere on suspicion and nothing has been recovered from possession of these

petitioners. It is further submitted that petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 12.11.2013
