2 31-01-2014 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 31.10.2013 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

The accusation is that 19 quintals of rice were recovered from a truck when it was suspected that it was being carried for black marketing from the P.D.S. shop of the petitioner.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that only on suspicion the accusation has been levelled.

Considering the period of custody and nature of accusation, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned
