The petitioner seeks bail in a case which has been  
registered under Sections 395, 397 of the Indian Penal Code  
against unknown 10 persons.

Submission is that the petitioner is not named in the  
FIR, has not been put on test identification parade and no  
incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. The
