Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Riga P.S. Case No. 64 of 2013 registered under Sections 304(B) and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased, Munni Devi and has falsely been implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. It is further submitted that deceased, Munni Devi, died due to illness and at that time informant was also present with the deceased but due to ulterior motive after five day of occurrence this false case has been lodged with allegation of demand of motorcycle and silver ornaments as dowry. It is also submitted that informant has stated in his written report that she came to know about the death of his daughter through her other daughter who resides in the place

of occurrence village, but her daughter, Jasia Devi, has stated about the presence of informant at the time of death of the deceased due to illness in course of carrying to hospital as detailed in paragraph 6 of the case diary. It is also submitted that petitioner is an old man aged about 72 years and he is in custody since 13.05.2013.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, in connection with Riga P.S. Case No. 64 of 2013.
