2 29-08-2014 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted
to make necessary correction in paragraph no. 3 of the
application during course of the day.

The petitioners, apprehend their arrest in
connection with a case registered for the offence
punishable under sections 341, 323, 307, 504/34 of the
Indian Penal Code, are named accused in this case of
assault in a petty dispute.

Submission is of false implication, general
and omnibus allegation. There is absolutely nothing specific

against these petitioners. Further, **petitioners carry no criminal antecedent.**

If, it is so, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within four weeks, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Masaurhi, Patna, in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 204/2013, subject to condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with additional condition to remain physically present before the court below on each and every date at least for two years or till disposal of the case, whichever is earlier and in case of failure on two consecutive dates without giving any reasonable explanation, the liberty granted shall be deemed to be cancelled.
