Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners seek quashing of the order of cognizance dated 19.8.2013 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna, in connection with Sessions Trial No. 1351 of 2013 arising out of Rupas Pur P.S. Case No. 72 of 2012.

Considering that the Petitioner seeks quashing on questions of fact which cannot be gone into at the stage of 482 Cr. P.C., I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application stands dismissed with a direction to the Trial Court to conclude the Trial expeditiously without granting unnecessary adjournment to any Party.
