learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application has been filed for the grant of  
regular bail to the petitioner who is in custody for offences  
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 435 of the  
Indian Penal Code, in connection with **Sessions Trial No.**  
**73/2014 arising out of Lakhisarai P.S. Case No. 404/1998**  
**pending in the court of learned Adhoc A.D.J.-Vth,**  
**Lakhisarai.**

This case is of the year 1998. Petitioner is one of  
the accused. Submission is of false implication, general and  
omnibus allegation and on the basis of amicable settlement  
between the parties and filing of compromise petitioner.  
Other co-accused have already been acquitted, but the  
petitioner under some confusion had left the place and now  
he is in custody since 18.12.2013. Trial of the case has  
already commenced.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and  
delay caused at the instance of petitioner, prayer for regular  
bail of the petitioner is hereby refused. Simultaneously, trial  
court is directed to proceed expeditiously and avoid undue  
delay and adjournment.
