Heard both sides.

Petitioners, Gopal Kumar and Shishupal Kumar, are accused in Bihta P.S. Case No. 364/2013 registered under Sections 395 and 412 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have, in fact, committed no offence. Name of the petitioners figured in the confessional statement of a co-accused. Thereafter, the petitioners were arrested and their confessional statements were also recorded. Except the confessional statements, there is nothing on the record to show involvement of the petitioners. The truck was recovered on the basis of the confessional statement of other accused. The petitioners were not put on T.I. Parade. Hence, the petitioners be

enlarged on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record.

Petitioners are not named in the F.I.R. They were arrested, but were not put on T.I. Parade. The petitioners are in jail since 26.09.2013.

Considering the facts and circumstances aforesaid, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., Danapur, Patna in Bihta P.S. Case No. 364/13.
