The petitioner seeks bail in a case which has been registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 376/511 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly taking the advantage of lonely place the petitioner tried to commit rape with the informant and on protest he gave knife blow on her private part causing injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks release of the petitioner placing his innocence, false implication and submitting that no offence under Section 307 or 376/511 of the Indian Penal Code is made out, the injury found on the person of the informant is simple vide Annexure-2, the petitioner is aged No

about 20 years whereas the informant is more than 55 years of age and in this false case he is suffering in custody since 11.8.2013 having no criminal antecedent.

The learned APP opposed the prayer for bail by submitting that the petitioner not only made an attempt to commit sexual assault but also caused injury.

Be that as it may considering the detention of the petitioner at this stage and allegation attributed and further considering his age now the petitioner Krishna Sahani is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 3rd Ad hoc Additional Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur in connection with Sessions Trial No. 82 of 2014, arising out of Paroo P.S. Case No. 112 of 2013.
