Heard both sides.

Petitioners, Rabari Devi, Jonha Devi and Heera Ram are accused in Bagaha P.S. Case No. 217 of 2013 registered under Sections 302, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Samarikha Devi alleged that her daughter was married to Heera Lal Ram about 10 years ago and all the accused persons subjected her to cruelty and killed her. It is submitted that there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioners and other accused persons. Brother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased, namely, Banarasi Ram and Jhapasi Ram have already been enlarged on

bail by this Court vide orders dated 06.03.2014 and 20.11.2013 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 46802/2013 and 46161/2013 respectively. The petitioners are sister-in-law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the deceased. The case of the petitioners stands on similar footing. Hence, the petitioners be enlarged on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

There appears to be omnibus and general allegation.

One brother-in-law and the father-in-law have already been enlarged on bail by this Court. The petitioners are sister-in-law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the deceased.

Considering the facts and circumstances aforesaid, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bagaha, West Champaran in Bagaha P.S. Case No. 217 of 2013.
