Petitioner is accused in connection with Chhatauni
P.S. Case No. 190 of 2013 arising out of Trial No. 958 of 2014
registered under Section 379 of the I.P.C.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., as
regarding missing of motorcycle of the informant, F.I.R. was
lodged against unknown under Section 379 of the I.P.C. In course
of investigation, the Police got recorded the confessional statement
of the petitioner showing his involvement in theft of motorcycle
and selling the same in Nepal. Except that, there is nothing against
the petitioner. It is also submitted that while petitioner is accused
in two other cases, but in both cases he is on bail and in the

present case, he is in custody since 06.11.2013.

Under the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Chhatauni P.S. Case No. 190 of 2013 arising out of Trial No. 958 of 2014.
