Heard Mr. R. Das, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. R.C. Debnath, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor appearing for the state. Mr. Debnath, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has produced the Case Diary. This is a petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail in favour of the petitioner, namely Sri Himangshu Biswas in connection with Teliamura P.S. Case No.09/2014, registered under Sections 498-A/109 of the IPC. The allegation as emerged in this petition is that the petitioner is having an illicit relation with the maid servant and when resisted, the complainant was brutally assaulted by the petitioner. After going through the nature of the allegations made, this court is of the view that the petitioner may be released on pre-arrest bail with certain conditions for protecting the interest of the investigation. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, Sri Himangshu Biswas in connection with Teliamura P.S. Case No.09/2014, registered under Sections 498-A/109 of the IPC, he shall be released on bail on furnishing the bail bond of `20,000 (rupees twenty thousand) supported by one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall report to the Investigating Officer on 03.02.2014 without fail and he shall continue to report to the Investigating Officer once in a week for the next 2(two) months. It is further directed that the petitioner shall not leave his ordinary place of residence without leaving prior intimation to the Investigating Officer and he shall not make any attempt to meddle with the investigation in any manner. With this observation and direction, this petition stands allowed and disposed of. The Case Diary so produced by Mr. R.C. Debnath, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor is returned.
