Heard Mr. Tayum Son, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Also heard Mr. R. H. Nabam, learned Senior Government Advocate, for State Respondents No. 1 to 5.

Upon instructions received from the instant writ petitioner, Mr. Son, learned counsel, has prayed that the instant writ petition may be disposed of on withdrawal, as the petitioner and the respondents have settled the matter outside the Court, amicably. However, learned counsel has prayed for liberty to file a fresh petition.

Prayer is allowed.

The petitioner is hereby permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs. 7,500/-, without fail, as an exemplary cost, in favour of the Gauhati High Court Itanagar Permanent Bench Bar Association (GHCIPBBA), Naharlagun, on or before 30th of December, 2014. Thereafter, the petitioner is at liberty to file a fresh petition, if so advised.

Interim order passed by this Court, on 08.08.2014, shall automatically stand vacated.

The connected misc. application viz. MC(WP) 112(AP)2014 filed by the petitioner, shall automatically stand closed as having become infructuous.
