By this application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner, namely, Mr. Anowar Hussain has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Khatuwal P.S. Case No. 31/2014 under Sections 448/148/326/379/34 IPC.

The allegation made against the petitioner is that the petitioner attacked the brother of the informant, namely, Mr. Haider Ali, on 12.07.2014 and caused grievous injuries to his person. The medical report collected by the I.O. supports the said contention.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for both the parties and considering the evidence so far collected by the I.O. as well as the nature of alleged offence, I do not find it to be a fit case to extend the benefit of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Hence, the prayer for pre-arrest bail is rejected.

Return the C.D.

The bail application is disposed of.
