Heard Mr. A.R. Bhuiya, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. N. Upadhyay, learned State Counsel.

The petitioners claiming themselves to be the persons living below poverty line and inclusion of their names in the IAY permanent waiting list are aggrieved by the Annexure-7 and 7(a) letters dated 10/12/2013 and 11/12/2013, by which the respondent No. 5 and 6 have directed the respondent No.7 for submission of another list of beneficiaries of IAY (MSDP) of Hailakandi Development Block, in spite of existence of the said permanent waiting list which was prepared in a meeting of the Gram Sabha held on 08/09/2012 (Annexure-6-a). According to the petitioners without first exhausting the permanent list, the authorities could not have recommended for preparation of another list.

Considering the nature of the grievance raised, the writ petition is disposed of at the motion stage itself granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent No.4 agitating their grievance. In the event of such representation being made within 10(ten) days from today, the said authority shall pass appropriate order in consultation with the concerned authorities, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one month thereafter. The recommendation for preparation of another list will be subject to the order passed by the authority in terms of this order.

With the above direction and observation, the writ petition stands disposed of, without however, any order as to costs.
