The petitioner is a Cooperative Society and they assailed the order dated 29.9.2008 (Annexure-10) of the Employees' Provident Funds organization, whereby the Society was directed to remit the provident fund dues quantified at Rs.16,13,046/- + interest, under the Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952. However on the basis of written instruction received from the client, Ms. S Sarma, learned counsel submits that the dispute on deposit of provident fund for the of the staff members of the petitioner society was amicably resolved and she has instruction to not to pursue the case.

The respondent No.8 i.e. the Guwahati Wholesale Consumers Cooperative Society Employees' Union is represented by Advocate Mr. LP Sharma but he has no information on the submission made by the petitioner's lawyer. Similar submission is made by Mr. D Dey, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos.2-6.

Having noted the above submission and considering the specific submission made by the petitioner's lawyer, the case is disposed of as not pressed. Interim order of 9.1.2009 merges with this final order.
