Heard Mr. B P Borah, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. B.S. Sin ha, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, Assam.

In this application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner, Sri Maina Bir Rabha, has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Latasil P.S. Case No. 169/2014 under Sections 366/511 IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 24.06.2014 learned Addl. Public Prosecutor h as produced the case diary.

On perusal of the case diary, more particularly the statement of the vic tim girl it appears that the victim was married to the present petitioner 5 (fiv e) years ago.

Having so, I do not find any material warranting custodial detention of the petitioner.

Accordingly, this pre-arrest bail application of the petitioner is allowed.

It is provided that in the event of the arrest of the petitioner, Sri Ma ina Bir Rabha in connection with Latasil P.S. Case No. 169/2014, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with one local surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.
