Heard Mr. Choudhury, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Goswami, learned st anding counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 3 and Mr. Ghosh, learn ed State counsel appearing for the respondent No. 4.

As agreed to by the learned counsel for the parties the writ petition is taken up for disposal at the motion stage itself.

The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that though the proce ss of selection for appointment to the post of junior assistant has been initiat ed, in which process the petitioner has participated, the authority is contempla ting to appoint the respondent No. 5 without publication of select list.

Mr. Goswami, learned standing counsel, Water Resource Department on the basis of the instruction has submitted that in view of the embargo put vide the order passed in WP(C) No. 4435/2013 and other similar matters no appointment could be made and hence there is no question of appointing any person without publication of the select list.

Having regard to the aforesaid submission, the writ petition is disposed of dire cting the respondents not to appoint anyone without publication of the select list.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
