Heard Ms. D Borgohain, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. R Mazumdar, the learned Standing counsel for Elementary Education Department appearing for the respondent Nos. 1 to 5.

The nature of the relief now claimed by the learned counsel for the petitioner d oes not require issuing formal notice to any of the respondents and as such this writ petition is being disposed of today at the motion stage.

The case of the petitioner is that she has been holding the charge of Head Tea cher of No. 128 Borpathar Jr. Basic School since 2003 when the respondent No. 3 was selected for the post of CRCC in SSA. She eventually joined the post. The re spondent No. 6 was given extension in the post of CRCC till January, 2014 where after he was repatriated to the school. While the petitioner is holding the charge of Head Teacher, the respondent No. 4 issued the order dated 28.8.14 allowing the respondent No. 6 to take charge of Head Teacher of the school in place of the petitioner. Aggrieved by this, the petitioner is filing this writ petition. It may be noted that the petitioner had earlier filed a representation to the respondent No. 4 on 1.9.14. The Deputy Director, Elementary Education, Assam by his letter dated 2.9.14 asked the respondent No. 4 to look into the grievance of the petitioner. The respondent No. 4 apparently has not disposed of the representation of the petitioner.

The respondent No. 4 is, therefore, directed to consider the representation date d 1.9.14 of the petitioner and take a decision thereon in accordance with law wi thin a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of this order. Till a decision in this behalf is taken by the respondent No. 4, the parties are directed to maintain the status-quo as on today.
