WP(C) 5503/2014 BEFORE HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE B.K. SHARMA

The petitioner is aggrieved by the Annexure-5 order dated 09/09/2013 by which he r services as Anganwadi Worker of 107 No. Simlabari Part-1 (C) Anganwadi Centre under Chapar Salkocha ICDS Project in the district of Dhubri has been dispensed with on the ground of misappropriation of SNP fund. As per the allegation made a gainst her, she has misappropriated the amount withdrawing from the joint Account No. 31488999221.

As indicated in the impugned order, there was complaint from the public. Mr. S. Islam, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order h as been passed without affording the petitioner an opportunity of being heard, t he same is liable to be interfered with. On the other hand, Mr. B.K. Sarma, lear ned Standing Counsel, Social Welfare Department submits that since the very appointment of the petitioner as Anganwadi Worker is honorary on payment of honorari um, she cannot claim protection under Article 311 of the Constitution of India.

Having regard to the nature of the grievance raised and considering the facts that the petitioner has already approached the authorities by filing Anneu xre-9 and 10 representations against the impugned order, the writ petition is di sposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Director of Social Welfare, Assam with an appropriate representation. In the event of such representation is made to the said authority, he will decide the matter taking note of a ll the attending facts and circumstances including the materials regarding misap propriation of the fund as alleged in the impugned order. Let the appropriate or der be passed as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months of making the representation by the petitioner along with a certified copy of this order. If need be, parties involved may also be heard.

There shall be no order as to costs.
