Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner has been made an accused for the offence registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 324, 307 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 27 of the Arms Act, Section 13 U.P.A. Act, 1967 and Section 17 of the C.L.A. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that two truck were set on fire by the extremists thereafter, counter ensued between the police and the member of the extremists in which two persons were apprehended on the spot, namely, Mantu Das and Ydhisthir Mahato and on the basis of confessional statement of the apprehended accused this petitioner along with other co-accused have been arrayed as accused; that co-accused, Yudhisthir Mahato and Ranjit Mahato @ Ranjit Kumar Mahato @ Mukesh Kumar Mahato have been granted bail in B.A. No. 5459 of 2013 and B.A. No. 2074 of 2014 respectively.

Learned A.P.P has not controverted the submissions advanced by the petitioner's counsel.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Saraikella in connection with Chowka P.S. Case No. 67 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 1037 of 2012.
