07/30.06.2014 Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties and perused the documents on record.

The learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that the applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No. 119 of 2013 corresponding to G.R. No. 311 of 2013 registered under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that the applicant is the Secretary of the NGO namely, Gramin Punarnirman Sahkarita Sansthan, Gumla. Though, the bills were submitted and out of total amount of Rs. 20 lacs, bills worth Rs. 15 lacs were duly accepted by the authorities and notice was issued to the applicant for returning the balance amount in the year, 2008, on the basis of false report the first information report has been registered on 08.04.2013. It is further submitted that in the year, 2010 itself a Certificate Case bearing no. 02 of 2011-12 was instituted against the present applicant however, after the new officer bearer assumed charge, a written complaint was given to the police and on that basis the first information report has been registered. He further submits that from the aforesaid facts, it would appear that the applicant has no fraudulent intention inasmuch as, bills worth Rs. 15 lacs have been accepted by the authorities.

The learned A.P.P. appearing for the State opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail and submits that there is no specific and direct allegation against the present applicant.

From the materials brought on record, I find that not only a part of bills submitted by the applicant was accepted by the authorities, the authorities issued notice to the applicant for returning the balance amount and a certificate case has also been instituted.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest of the applicant namely, Ram Jatan Sahu or if he surrenders before the trial court within a period of four weeks from today, he would be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gumla in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No. 119 of 2013 corresponding to G.R. No. 311 of 2013.
