5/31.01.2014: Bail application filed by petitioner Namita @ Namita Rai is moved by Sri Ramesh Kumar Singh and opposed by Mrs. Rashmi Kumari, learned Additional P.P.

Earlier bail prayer of petitioner rejected. However it appears that she is in custody from last about three years. From perusal of status report, it appears that up till now, four witnesses has already been examined. From perusal of certified copy of depositions of those witnesses, it appears that they have only stated that they saw the petitioner while she was fleeing away from the place of occurrence. There is no chance of early disposal of this case because still 37 witnesses are to be examined by the prosecution.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstance, specially taking into account that petitioner is a lady and is languishing in jail custody from last about three years, I allow this application and direct the court below to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District & Additional Sessions Judge-II, Dumka in connection with Kathikund P.S. Case No. 45 of 2010 (G.R. No. 1117 of 2010, S.T. No. 60 of 2011).
