The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with the case registered under Sections 414, 467, 468, 471, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 33 of Indian Forest Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have been made an accused as petitioner No.1 & 2 are the registered owner of the truck bearing No.JH-02N-2097 & JH-02J-9721 respectively; that they have no concern with the seized coal, neither they forged any document nor were they present on the spot; that on similar allegation co-accused namely Munna Khan has been granted bail in A.B.A. No.3826 of 2013.

Learned A.P.P for the State while opposing the prayer for bail application of the petitioners, has not controverted the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and in the event of their arrest or surrender, the Court below shall grant bail to the above named petitioners on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist class, Hazaribag in connection with Barhi P.S. Case No.110 of 2013, Corresponding to G.R. No.1263 of 2013, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
