Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegation against the petitioner is that he and co-accused Jai Prakash gave something from their pockets to another co-accused Dhananjay Ram who fired at the victim. He has further submitted that although the incident took place on 9<sup>th</sup> of June 2014 and the injured was admitted in RIMS after being taken from one hospital to another, the First Information Report was instituted after three days i.e on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2014. Lastly he has submitted that petitioner is in custody since 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2013 .

Learned counsel for State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that although no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner but he was standing along with Dhananjay Ram when the incident had taken place.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Vijay Ram is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Palamau in connection with Haidarnagar P.S Case No. 36 of 2014 corresponding to G.R No. 1023 of 2014.
