Petitioner has been made accused for the offence under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act, in connection with Jagarnathpur P.S. Case No.331 of 2013, corresponding to G.R. No.6722 of 2013.

The case relates to murder of the husband of the informant and the informant had seen the deceased at a hotel along with the petitioner and the other co-accused persons. The informant was informed that her husband was injured by the firearm, whereupon, she went there and found her husband injured. While she was taking her husband to the hospital, her husband informed that his friends, including the petitioner had assaulted him by firearm. Thereafter, the deceased died.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and has prayed for bail.

The impugned order shows that the witnesses including the owner of the hotel have stated that the deceased was sitting with this petitioner and the other co-accused persons. The deceased has named the petitioner also, who had assaulted him.

In the facts and circumstances of this case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner Dullu @ Rakesh on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail stands dismissed.
