**3/30.08.2014** Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sisai P.S. Case No. 82 of 2011, corresponding to G.R. No.536 of 2011, for the offence under Sections 467/468/471/420 of the Indian Penal Code.

There is direct allegation against the petitioner to have obtained the job in Indian Army on the basis of forged caste certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and has accordingly, prayed for anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and has submitted that the petitioner has committed a serious offence.

In the facts of this case and taking into consideration the allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Ravinder Sahu. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.
