Petitioner is said to be in custody since 24.07.2014 in  
connection with Jamtara P.S. Case No. 280 of 2014  
corresponding to G. R. No. 751 of 2014 for the offence under  
Sections 379/414/34 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the  
Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamtara.

It is submitted that the only allegation that can be made  
out against the petitioner is that he purchased the stolen  
motorcycle from Sahban Ansari, who was arrested and on his  
statement a raid was conducted. Apart from that the petitioner  
is a businessman having no criminal antecedent. He does not  
have any concern with the said accused. Therefore, he may be  
enlarged on bail.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for  
bail of the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having  
regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case,  
petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail  
bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two  
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned  
Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamtara in connection with Jamtara  
P.S. Case No. 280 of 2014 corresponding to G. R. No. 751 of  
2014.
