05/ 28.11.2014 Compliance report has been filed in the matter showing the total admissible amount of Rs. 10,53,834/- under different heads of post retirement and other benefits. It is stated that some payment has been made and the balance would be paid in monthly installments and if the petitioner has any grievance in relation to computation of the amounts under different heads, he is at liberty to make objection within fifteen days.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that payments in monthly installments have not yet commenced.

3. Be that as it may, the opposite party seem to have passed a reasoned order indicating admissible amounts due to the petitioner. As per the reasoned order, the amounts admissible are to be paid in monthly installments. Therefore, opposite party should commence payments of the balance admissible amounts in monthly installments from the next month. However, it would be open to the petitioner to submit the bank account details to the officials of the opposite party-MADA, so that payments could also be disbursed through the bank account.

4. In that view of the matter, contempt petition is disposed of. Proceedings are dropped.
