Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and that it is said that the looted motorcycle was recovered from the joint possession of one Bikas Tiwari and petitioner and country made pistols were recovered from their separate possession. It is further submitted that co-accused Maksud Alam from whose possession looted mobile has been recovered, has been granted bail by this Court vide order passed in B.A. No. 8262 of 2013. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 10.2.2012.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that there is direction allegation of committing dacoity against the petitioner

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Palamau in connection with S.T. No. 354 of 2013 arising out of Sadar (Satbarwa O.P.) P.S. Case No. 572 of 2012 (G.R. Case No. 2215 of 2012).
