**03/ 31.10.2014** The petitioner is an accused in a case registered under Sections 25(1-b) a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

It reveals from the F.I.R. that the petitioner and her associates were arrested from a room of a house and they were found in possession of three pistols and cartridges which were kept in a ladies bag.

It is submitted that co-accused Aman Verma, who was also apprehended from the said room, has been granted bail by a Bench of this Court on 16.09.2014 vide B.A.No. 5277 of 2014. The petitioner happens to be a lady, who is rotting in jail since more than six months.

Counsel for the State has opposed the prayer.

It appears that co-accused having similar allegation has been granted bail, the petitioner deserves same benefit and accordingly she is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- ( Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the C.J.M., Sahebganj in connection with Sahebganj (T) P.S. Case No. 60/2014, corresponding to G.R.No. 179/2014.
