Heard.</p> <p>It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner has neither been suspended nor terminated or dismissed from service. The petitioner was facing of criminal trial and finally, he has been acquitted by this Court vide order dated 01.08.2014 passed in Criminal Appeal No.476/2011. It is the case of the petitioner that he is not being allowed to work on the post of Shiksha Karmi Grade-III.</p> <p>Upon being enquired, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is neither any order of suspension nor termination or dismissal passed against him but the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Panchayat orally directed that work be not taken from the petitioner.</p> <p>Whether the petitioner himself was avoiding to work or there was any order terminating or suspending him due to which he was deprived from work. He has submitted representation before the Chief Executive Officer, the Chief Executive Officer should decide his application and pass a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order passed by this Court.</p>
