Shri Y.S.Thakur, Dy.A.G. for the State. With the consent of the partiles, the matter is heard finally. The petitioner has filed this petition aggrieved by rejection of candidature for appointment to the post of Patwari initiated vide advertisement dated 25/01/14. The issue which arises for consideration in this petition is as whether the petitioner was holding eligibility qualification as prescribed in clause 10 of the advertisement. The petitioner, without dispute, has obtained diploma in computer application from C.V. Raman University. Clause 10 of the advertisement exhaustively enumerates eligibility qualification. The petitioner is only possessed of diploma qualification from C.V.Raman University and not from recognized ITI, Government Polytechnic institution, Board of Technical Education, State Technical University Or DOEACC Society, New Delhi. The qualification possessed by the petitioner, apparently therefore, is not one of the eligibility qualifications prescribed in clause 10 of the advertisement. The submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that one similarly situated candidate was allowed to participate holding him

eligible, does not help the petitioner. If the petitioner does not hold
